THE FIRE AND RESCUE FORCE (SAFETY INSPECTION, CERTIFICATES AND LEVY) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2022

Citation

GN. No. 106 of 2008 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fire and Rescue Force (Safety Inspections, Certificates and Levy) (Amendment) Regulations, 2022 and shall be read as one with the Fire and Rescue Force (Safety Inspection, Certificates and Levy) Regulations, 2008 herein after referred as the "principal Regulations".

Amendment of regulation 3

2. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 3(1) by deleting the word "First" and substituting for it the word "Third".

Amendment of regulation 5

- **3.** The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 5-
 - (a) in subregulation (1) by deleting the word "writing" and substituting for it the words "Form A specified in the First Schedule to

these Regulations"; and

- (b) by adding immediately after subregulation (1) the following:
 - "(2) Where upon fire incident, the owner or operator of the inspected premise, vehicle, vessel or any other conveyance facility in respect of which the incident occurred shall request a fire incident report and the Fire Authority shall, upon being satisfied with the compliance to these Regulations, issue to such owner or operator a fire incident report in Form B specified in the First Schedule to these Regulations."; and
- (c) renumbering subregulation (2) as subregulation (3).

Amendment of regulation 9

- **4.** The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 9 by-
 - (a) designate the contents of regulation 9 as subregulation (1);
 - (b) adding the words "and protection" immediately after the word "precaution" appearing in the marginal note and subregulation (1) as designated; and
 - (c) adding immediately after subregulation (1) as designated the following:
 - "(2) The fees for inspection of fire precaution and protection plan for premises under construction, demolition, alteration or design stage shall be charged in accordance with the Fourth Schedule to these Regulations.
 - (3) Where the purpose group of building requires special fire services, the total fee shall be determined by the sum of the base fee for built-up area in a particular purpose group and each product of percentage calculated from the fire levy

group 1 for the required special fire service against the base fee for built-up area in that respective purpose group.".

Amendment of regulation 6

5. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 6(3) by deleting the word "First" appearing in paragraph (d) and substituting for it the word "Second".

Deletion and substitution of regulation 12A

6. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 12 and substituting for it the following:

"Fire inspection report

12. Upon completion of inspection, the Fire Authority shall issue a fire inspection report form to the owner or operator of the premise, vehicle, vessel or any other conveyance facility in a form specified in the Fifth Schedule to these Regulations."

Amendment of regulation 14

- **7.** The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 14-
 - (a) in subregulation (2) by inserting the words "specified in the Third Schedule to these Regulations" between the words "fee" and "in" appearing in the opening phrase; and
 - (b) in subregulation (3) by-
 - (i) adding immediately after paragraph (s)-
 - "(t) sales, servicing and installation of portable fire fighting appliances, fire suppression system, fire alarm and detection system"; and
 - (ii) renaming paragraph (t) and (u) as paragraph (u) and (v) respectively.

Amendment of regulation 6

8. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 18(2) by deleting the word "Third" and

substituting for it the word "Sixth".

Amendment of Schedules

9. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting the Schedules and substituting for them the following:
